"My Dear and brave Punjabis..

The past ten years have been a period of unprecedented progress and development in Punjab. The state has witnessed path-breaking initiatives in most areas of progress, including agriculture, business, trade and industry, education, health, sports, investment and social welfare sectors. The basic infrastructure in the state underwent a complete revamp with four-lane and six-lane expressways coming up. The state which used to reel under power-cuts for 14 to 18 hours every day is now power surplus. To beat the disadvantage of being land-locked, the state now has two international and three domestic airports. Every section of society is getting direct government support as incentive or assistance to take the state and its people forward. Punjabi farmers are the only farmers who get agricultural power free of cost. Several needy sections of society are also getting domestic power free.

Similarly, several other unprecedented facilities are extended to different sections of society, such as Atta Daal to the poor, the small farmers and traders, free medical treatment up to Rs 50,000 and accidental death insurance of Rs Five lakh for bread winners of these families. Intelligent students are encouraged to push forward with even better results with liberal scholarships of Rs 30,000 under Dr. Hargobind Khurana scholarship scheme. Girl students in schools are being given free bicycles as incentives for education.

The state government is acting a strong defender of states' rights over critical areas such as river waters and territorial issues. The SAD-BJP government put the issue of SYL construction beyond the area of human possibility by returning the land acquired for this canal to the original farmers. The state never had a drop of water to spare through this canal. Now, it does not have an inch of land to build the canal either. The SAD will never allow SYL to be built. I will rather make the supreme sacrifice with my life rather than allow this canal to be built. Everybody who has known for the past sixty years of public life knows this too well. The state remains the most peaceful region in the country and despite many challenges, it enjoys an atmosphere of complete communal harmony.

One of the proudest moments in my life was the walk through the Heritage Street around the Holy Sri Harmandar Sahib in Guru Ki Nagari, Sri Amritsar Sahib. I humbly thank the Almighty for giving us this opportunity to serve our heritage and our masses with a project which has won worldwide acclaim.

As we go into the elections, I approach you with a humble request to have a look around yourself and see if the claims being made about progress and development in the state and about the welfare measures being extended to different sections of society are true or not. I am sure that it will be so easy to see that Punjab today has come a long, long way forward from where it was ten years ago. In fact, anyone visiting Punjab after a gap of ten years would find it hard to recognize many parts of Punjab as the same that he or she had left behind a decade ago.

I request you to exercise your right to vote not through bias, anger, greed or any other consideration but through independent, fair and impartial judgment. Just keep one thing in mind. Did the government work honestly on every front to take the state forward into the new age of development and prosperity or not? Then, look around at reality around you for an honest answer.

Indeed, there are still challenges to be met. With your support, we are already engaged in fighting those challenges. But we need your support so that the process of development is not stopped or slowed down.

I request you to ask yourself: "Do those who call us criminals and drug addicts deserve our vote?" If your answer is "No", then it is our duty to teach these elements a lesson.


Everybody knows that the welfare schemes such as free power to farmers, pensions, shaguns, Atta Daal, free Teerath yatra, free medical treatment of Rs 50,000 or Cancer Relief of Rs One lakh fifty thousand (1 lakh 50,000 per patient) etc. will be stopped in the first month itself if any political party other than the SAD-BJP forms a government in Punjab. These are policies and schemes started by us and we have continued with them for nearly fifteen years. International Airport at Mohali. Today, this great dream of Punjabis also is a reality already. International flights have already commenced and soon, the entire world will be connected aurally connected with Punjab. Sardar Parkash Singh Badal, who is rightly known as the farmer's messiah, courageously decided to give free power to farmers. The facility was withdrawn by Captain Amarinder Singh when he was the Chief Minister. Punjab is the first and the only state to introduce this relief for farmers

Shagun Scheme for Dalit and other poor sections daughters. This a token of our love for the poor that the government cares for their households and regards their daughters as its own responsibility. Now not only Dalits but even Christians and Muslim families are also covered under the scheme. This scheme under which the state give Rs 15,000 at the time of the wedding of the daughters of families of these sections too was stopped by the Congress government headed by Captain Amarinder Singh. Punjab only state to do so.

The pension of senior citizens, widows and helpless ladies and orphan children has been doubled from Rs 250 to Rs 500- Punjab is the only state to give it.

Every girl child in poor families gets a help of Rs 61,000 under Babe Nanaki Ladli Beti Scheme. The scheme has already been in force for five years. Punjab only state to do so.

Atta Daal scheme; Punjab first and only state to do so. The number of beneficiaries of this scheme was increased from 15 lakhs initially to nearly 35 lakhs now, covering about 1.5 crore population of the state.

We implemented our promise to give Rs 30,000 scholarship to meritorious students. Punjab is the only state where such a scheme, known as Dr. Hargobind Khurana Scheme is in force.

saints and seers. It has also been the principal crusader for the rights of and justice to India's minorities, including the Sikhs as per the goals and ideals enshrines in the Constitution of India. Punjab is the food-bowl and the sword arm of India. Punjabis have made unprecedented contribution in the country's struggle for freedom. Despite being just about 2% of the overall population of the country, Punjabis share in the cause of freedom exceeded 80 to 85% by way of those who suffered life sentence, and kala pani. The percentage of those who laid down their lives for the nation is even greater and is close to 95%. Some of the most powerful movements before independence were launched from Punjab, including the Gaddar Lehar, the Babbar Akali Lehar, the Pagri Smbhal Jatta Lehar, the Namdhari Kooka Lehar, Kamagata Maru etc. Similarly, Punjabis topped the list of those who kissed martyrdom for the mother land, with Shaheed-e-Azam Sardar Bhagat Singh, Shaheed udham Singh, Shaheed Kartar Singh Sarbha, Lala Lajpat Rai, Madan Lal Dhingra being just some of the names that readily come to mind.

With a role as outstanding as this, it was expected that powers that be after the freedom of the country would acknowledge and value the role played by Punjabis and would accord them a place of high honour in the country. But right from the start, Punjabis were subjected to discrimination and injustice on almost every front. Linguistic states were made throughout the country to ensure that the cultural heritage of people of each region was preserved and promoted. But in the case of Punjab alone was this right denied, forcing Punjabis to undertake a long and painful struggle to secure a Punjabi Suba. Finally, when this right of the people of the state was acknowledged, they were subjected to injustice and discrimination on territorial and river waters issues. Vast Punjabi Speaking areas were kept out of the state and even the state was denied even its Capital Chandigarh, the only instance of a parent state being denied its right over the capital of the state.

The biggest blow was dealt on the issue of the river waters of the state. River waters are the only natural asset which the people of the state have. Water is the life line of Punjabis, Punjab being a predominantly agrarian state. There is well-laid nationally and internationally principle to determine all issues arising out of disputes over river waters. This principle, known as the Riparian Principle, stipulates that the waters of a river belong exclusively to the state or country through which the said river passes. As per this principle, Punjab is the sole proprietor of the entire volume of Punjab's river waters. But Punjab has consistently been robbed of its only natural resource.

This has been done by subjecting Punjab to injustice by successive Congress governments both at the center and in Punjab. The Akali government led by Sardar Parkash Singh Badal first took the matter to the Supreme Court for adjudication on the rights of states on the river waters as per the Riparian Principle. Almost all experts agree that Punjab had a fool proof case in the matter and would have a verdict in its favor. But as the government of Sardar Parkash Singh Badal was replaced by the Congress government headed by Sardar Darbara Singh, the case was withdrawn under pressure from the then Prime Minister Mrs Indira Gandhi. Subsequently, the Punjab government was coerced into agreeing to construct the SYL canal to take Punjab's waters to Haryana. The then Chief Minister Sardar Darbara Singh and eminent Congress leaders including Captain Amarinder Singh not only invited the then Prime Minister Mrs Indira Gandhi to start the digging of the canal at Kapoori village but even presented her with silver spade to do so. This was a case of broad daylight treachery with Punjab by Congress leaders. The same day and at the same time and the same venue, Shiromani Akali Dal workers led by Sardar Parkash Singh Badal courted arrest protesting against this loot of Punjab's priceless waters.

On the formation of an Akali government again, the Chief Minister Sardar Parkash Singh Badal took the issue of the rights of the state over its river waters as per the Riparian Principle, and that case is still pending before the Supreme Court.

CONGRESS, PUNJAB & 1984

The year 1984 was the climax of sustained injustice to and discrimination against the people of Punjab, particularly the most patriotic and valiant minority Sikh community by the successive Congress governments both in the state and at the center.

The height of injustice and repression was an armed attack with tanks and mortars on the holiest of the Holy shrines of humanity, Shri Harmandar Sahib in which Sri Akal Takhat Sahib suffered grievous damage. Sikh hearts still bleed with pain over the army assault on Darbar Sahib ordered by a Congress government under Mrs Indira Gandhi.

The climax of this most horrendous series of injustice and repression against the Sikhs was reached in the most shocking, unprecedented and unbelievable massacre carried out against thousands of innocents Sikhs men, women and children in November 1984. Their homes and other properties were either looted or torched by the organized gangs and mobs of goondas led by prominent Congress leaders whose names and the role they played have been documented by eminent jurists, civil liberties and human rights organizations, journalists and other intellectuals. Instead of punishing the guilty, the Congress party chose to reward many of them, including Jagdish Tytler, Sajjan Kumar, HKL Bhagat etc, with the highest offices in the country, including berths in the Union Cabinet. The Congress party, far from being shamed by the exposures of their criminal role, has the cheek and the brazen-ness to seek votes in Punjab.





10. The Vadda and Chhota Ghallughara memorials at Kup Rahiraan and Kahnuwan respectively have also come up to make the memory of these most stirring moments from our history.
11. The Jang-e-Azadi Yadgar in Kartarpur Sahib near Jalandhar stands out as a great tribute to the matchless contribution of Punjabis to the Freedom Movement.
12. The Jangi Yadgar (War Memorial), also the first of its kind in the country, recalls the bravery of Punjabis in the wars since 1947, and others.





SPORTS

Even as the critics of Punjab were busy dubbing our youth as drug addicts, Punjab's sports persons continued to excel in every field. The Punjab boys excelled as the country won the World Championship in Junior Hockey. 



- To fully rehabilitate victims of drug abuse, a new policy for incentivisation will be started under which former addicts are helped and more addicts are encouraged to return to healthy life.






